- (a)&(b): Yes, Madam. To fulfill the objective of taking up projects overseas, India Ports Global Pvt. Ltd. has been established in 2015 with equity contribution from Jawaharlal Nehru Port and Kandla Port Trusts. An agreement was signed by India Ports Global Pvt. Ltd with Aria Banader, Iranian a Private Company in Iran on 23.05.2016 for equipping and operating of Container Terminal and Multipurpose Terminals in Phase I of development plan of Chabahar-Shahid Behesti Port in the Islamic Republic of Iran.
- (c) The Government of India has not signed any MoU with Coastal companies overseas.
- (d) Does not arise.
