IMPACT ON AYURVEDIC MEDICINES STORED IN PLASTIC CONTAINERS

4854. SHRI MULLAPPALLY RAMACHANDRAN:

Will the Minister of AYURVEDA, YOGA AND NATUROPATHY, UNANI, SIDDHA AND HOMOEOPATHY (AYUSH) be pleased to state:

- (a) whether a study has been conducted on the impact of storing ayurvedic medicines in plastic containers;
- (b) if so, the details and findings thereof;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to make it compulsory for producers of Ayurvedic medicines to use glass bottles/ containers for packaging of various medicines; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE (IC) OF THE MINISTRY OF AYURVEDA, YOGA & NATUROPATHY, UNANI, SIDDHA AND HOMOEOPATHY (SHRI SHRIPAD YESSO NAIK)

- (a) & (b): No study has been conducted on the impact of using plastic containers for keeping Ayurvedic medicines. However, Rule 161-B of the Drugs and Cosmetics Rules, 1945 has been substituted for mentioning shelf life or date of expiry of medicine.
- (c): No such proposal has been mooted by the Government.
