(a) and (b): Government of India poses a bouquet of proposals in every financial year to Government of Japan / Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) for Official Development Assistance (ODA) depending on the proposal(s) received from various central Ministries/ Departments. The final selection of projects for external funding is made by Government of Japan. During the current financial year, Government of India has posed three projects pertaining to Ministry of Urban Development for JICA ODA loan. The details of projects is given below:
