(a) & (b): 14.5% vacancies in Group 'C' posts and 24.5% vacancies in Group 'D' posts are reserved for ex-servicemen (including 4.5% for disabled ex-servicemen and dependents of those killed in action) in Central Public Sector Undertakings and in Public Sector Banks.

5% of vacancies falling under direct recruitment quota in Group 'C' posts are reserved for appointment on compassionate grounds to dependant family member of a Government servant dying in harness or who is retired on medical grounds. Inter alia this scheme is applicable to a member of the Armed Forces who dies during service or is killed in action or is medically boarded out and is unfit for civil employment.
