(a) whether the Government has taken necessary steps to anticipate and interdict terrorist strikes in an effective manner;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether the Government proposes to build its own military-industrial complex under the -Make in Indiaøprogramme; and

(d) if so, the details thereof?

(a) & (b): All inputs pertaining to likelihood of terrorists strikes are being synthesised and shared promptly with multi agency centre as well as security forces on ground. Based on assessment of ground situation, suitable measures are taken to thwart threat of terrorist strikes. The Counter Terrorism grid has been revitalised and additional forces have been inducted in the affected areas to check the movement of terrorists. Gathering and dissemination of technical and human intelligence has been prioritized and intelligence sharing coordination carried out to forewarn the ground troops of terrorist movement.

(c) & (d): At present there is no proposal of the Government to build its own military – industrial complex under the 'Make in India' programme. However, Government, under 'Make in India' initiatives, encourages the participation of Indian Defence industry in defence production through various policy measures.
