Development of Minority Schools

691. SHRI PRABHAKAR REDDY KOTHA;

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Ministry has received any request from the State of Telangana seeking release of funds to the tune of Rs. 500 crores for welfare, establishment and development of minority schools in the State;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has considered the request; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

Minister of State in the Ministry of Human Resource Development (SHRI UPENDRA KUSHWAHA)

(a)&(b): No Madam, Ministry of Human Resource Development has not received any such proposal from State Government of Telangana. However, the Ministry of Minority Affairs has reported that they had received request from the State of Telangana for construction of 120 Residential School Complexes for Minorities students under Multi-sectoral Development Plan (MsDP). The total cost of the proposed projects was Rs. 2760.00 crores.

(c)&(d): After examination of the request of the State Government of Telangana, the Ministry of Minority Affairs has reported that they have approved the projects located in identified minority concentration areas as incorporated in the guidelines for implementation of Restructured MsDP. Accordingly, approval has been given for construction of 7 Residential School Complexes for Minorities in Nizamabad Town, Bodhan Town, Zahirabad Block, Tandur Town, Adilbad Town, Kagazanagar Town and Rajendranagar Town.
