Admissions in Technical Institutes

697. SHRI K. PARASURAMAN:

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the number of students getting admitted to Government and private engineering colleges and institutes excluding Indian Institutes of Technology (IITs) and National Institutes of Technology (NITs) is recording a steady decline;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether the All India Council of Technical Education has analysed the reasons behind the such decline in admission; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the corrective steps taken by the Government in this regard?

(a) & (b): Yes Madam, based on the enrolment data available for AICTE approved technical institutions, there is decline in admissions in certain courses. The information on the enrolment data for last 4 years for AICTE approved technical institutions is at Annexure.

(c): The increase and decrease of admissions to technical education courses depend on market demand and employment potential for such courses.

(d): The technical institutions are given liberty to reduce intake or even to close down certain courses for which there is less demand or no demand due to less employment potential for such courses. Based on such requests from technical institutions, AICTE grants approval for reduction in intake and closure of courses.
