Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware that fifty percent reservation has been provided for the students of Scheduled caste/Scheduled Tribe in admissions in Ambedkar University, Lucknow;
- (b) if so, whether the university administration is duly complying with the norms laid down regarding admissions; and
- (c) the manner in which remaining seats are filled up?

ANSWER

(a) to (c): Yes, Madam. The Babasaheb Bhimrao Ambedkar University (BBAU), Lucknow has been providing fifty percent reservation to the students of Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe in admissions as per clause 9 of Chapter VII of First Academic Ordinance framed in pursuance of Section 5(xxi) of the Babasaheb Bhimrao Ambedkar University Act, 1994.

As per the information provided by the University, the norms regarding admissions are followed. The remaining seats are also filled up in accordance with said Ordinance.
