Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has accorded approval to the State open universities for running M. Phil. and Ph.D. courses;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the State open universities have given affidavits in this regard; and
- (d) if so, the number of such universities in the States/UTs?

(a to d): As per the information furnished by the University Grants Commission (UGC) that based on the request of the Vice-Chancellors of the following four (04) Open & Distance Learning (ODL) mode universities, the Commission has permitted them to conduct M.Phil/Ph.D. programme strictly in accordance with the UGC (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil/Ph.D) Regulations, 2016 notified on 5th July, 2016:

- (i) The Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU), New Delhi,
- (ii) The Madhya Pradesh Bhoj (Open) University, Bhopal,
- (iii) The Pt. Sundarlal (Open) University, Chhattisgarh and
- (iv) The Uttarakhand (Open) University, Uttarakhand

These Universities have also submitted Affidavits to the effect that they will follow the said Regulations, 2016 of the UGC strictly without any deviation.
