(a) Several studies including explorations and excavations have been carried out both by the Governmental and non-governmental organizations along the palaeochannel, represented today by the Ghaggar river in Haryana, Punjab, Rajasthan and Gujarat. Some researchers have ascribed this palaeochannel to the Sarasvati river mentioned in Ancient Indian Literature.
(b) The Ministry of Culture has constituted the Advisory Committee for the Multi-disciplinary \& Study of the Sarasvati basin on 16.09.2015 for a period of two years, which has been (c) notified in the Gazettee Notification No. S.O. 3019 (E) dated 6 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ November 2015 of which a meeting was called under the Chairmanship of the Hon'ble Minister for Culture and Tourism on $25^{\text {th }}$ July 2016.
