Central Universities in Meghalaya

820. SHRI VINCENT H. PALA:

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of Central Universities in the State of Meghalaya;
- (b) the status of Central Agriculture University (CAU) in Meghalaya and courses being offered; and
- (c) whether the Government plans to shift the CAU to any other States, and if so, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DR. MAHENDRA NATH PANDEY)

- (a): There is one Central University, viz., North Eastern Hill University (NEHU) at Shillong under the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India.
- (b): There is no Central Agricultural University (CAU) in Meghalaya. However, Central Agricultural University, Imphal, Manipur under the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, has 3 colleges in Meghalaya viz., (i) College of Post Graduate Studies, Umiam, Meghalaya offering M.Sc. & Ph.D. Degree courses in various discipline of Agriculture, (ii) College of Agriculture, Kyrdemkulai, Ri-Bhoi District, Meghalaya offering B.Sc. Degree courses, and (iii) College of Home Science, Tura, Meghalaya offering B.Sc., M.Sc. & Ph.D. Degree in Home Science.
- (c): According to Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, there is no such proposal.
