Will the Minister of CULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is planning to open the cultural universities in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise including Uttar Pradesh;
- (c) the number of cultural universities functioning in the country at present, state-wise;
- (d) whether the Government has given any funds for the improvement and enhancement of these universities and if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) whether all these universities are affiliated by Government and UGC and if so, the details thereof?

- (c) There are no institutions under the administrative control of Ministry of Culture named as Cultural Universities. However, there are four teaching institutions declared as deemed to be Universities under Ministry of Culture, Government of India.
