Will the Minister of CULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any scheme to provide financial assistance to carry out repairs of Churches, Mosques, Gurudwaras and Temples;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the total number of protected ancient Temples, Gurudwaras, Mosques and Churches in the country, State-wise;
- (c) whether these religious sites are regularly repaired and properly maintained by Archaeological Survey of India;
- (d) if so, the details thereof along with the funds allocated and expenditure incurred thereon during the last three years, State-wise and structure-wise; and
- (e) the other remedial steps taken by the Government to maintain these religious places?

- (a) Yes Madam. There is a scheme to provide financial assistance to monuments less than 100 years old. So far in the last three years, financial assistance is provided to the following monuments.
