Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has taken any steps to ensure smooth return of the people who were evacuated from their villages after the surgical strikes in PoK;
- (b) if so, the details of the security assurance given to the villagers from four States that borders Pakistan; and
- (c) the steps being taken by the Government with respect to rehabilitation work in this area?

## ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI KIREN RIJIJU)

(a) to (c): The State Governments concerned along Indo- Pakistan Border have taken adequate steps for security and smooth return of the people who were evacuated from their villages after the surgical strikes in PoK. Necessary boarding/lodging and relief camp arrangements were made for such people.
