(a) whether the Government has taken any steps to ensure smooth return of the people who were evacuated from their villages after the surgical strikes in PoK;

(b) if so, the details of the security assurance given to the villagers from four States that borders Pakistan; and

(c) the steps being taken by the Government with respect to rehabilitation work in this area?
