Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) the status and details of assistance provided under the National Project on Organic Farming (NPOF) scheme through NABARD for setting up of fruit and vegetable market, waste/agriculture waste compost unit to various State Governments including Chhattisgarh; and
- (b) the details of the funds allocated and spent by the Government for the purpose during the last three years and the current year, State-wise?

**ANSWER**

(a) & (b): The Government is promoting the establishment of fruit/vegetable market/agro waste compost production unit 100 Ton Per Day (TPD)/3000 Ton Per Annum (TPA) capacity under Capital Investment Subsidy Scheme (CISS) through National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD). The financial assistance is provided by NABARD to farmers/individual/private agencies including the youth @33% of Total Financial Outlay (TFO) limited to Rs.63 lakh, whichever is less. The details of funds released as subsidy to various states for setting up of fruit/vegetable market waste compost production unit is given in **Annexure**.
