- (a) the present status of various Extension, Renovation and Modernisation Irrigation projects in the country including Phase-I of Grand Anicut Canal system project in Tamil Nadu;
- (b) whether the Technical Advisory Committee has approved these projects and if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the time by which these projects are likely to be completed?

STATEMENT REFERRED IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (c) OF STARRED QUESTION NO. *102. ANSWERED ON 09.02.2017 IN LOK SABHA REGARDING "IRRIGATION PROJECTS" ASKED BY SHRI K. PARASURAMAN:

(a) to (c) Central Water Commission (CWC) has reported that out of 32 project proposals under appraisal during XII plan, 23 proposals including Grand Anicut Canal system have been accepted by the Advisory Committee of this Ministry on Irrigation, Flood Control and Multipurpose projects and 4 projects have been sent back due to non-compliance of the observations. The details of 23 ERM projects accepted by the Advisory Committee is at **Annexure-I** and the appraisal status of balance ERM projects is at **Annexure – II**.

The proposals of Grand Anicut Canal System of Tamil Nadu has been accepted by Advisory Committee in its 130th meeting held on 30.09.2016 for an estimated cost of Rs. 2298.75 crore with benefits to an area of 1.0 Lakh Ha. However, project authorities have not submitted proposal for investment clearance.

Further, Water Resources Projects are planned, funded, executed and maintained by the State Governments themselves as per their own resources and priority. In order to supplement the efforts of the State Governments, MoWR, RD & GR provides financial assistance to State Governments to encourage sustainable development and efficient management of water resources through various schemes such as Accelerated Irrigation Benefits Programme (AIBP) etc. under Pradhan Manti Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY). Further, inclusion of the projects under various schemes for central assistance is considered after all necessary statutory clearances as well as investment clearance is obtained by project authorities and is subject to fulfillment of conditions laid down in the guidelines of schemes, availability of budget etc.

Forty two (42) approved ERM projects have been included under AIBP since its inception. Central Assistance of Rs. 2845.27 crore has been released for these projects upto Dec., 2016. Out of these 42 ERM projects, 20 ERM projects have been reported to be completed by State Governments. The issues related to completion of ongoing AIBP projects were considered by a committee constituted under the Chairmanship of Minister (WR), Chhattisgarh. The Committee, in consultation with States has identified 99 ongoing AIBP projects including 9 ERM projects for completion in phases by Dec., 2019 The details of prioritized 9 ERM projects is at **Annexure-III**.
