Assessment of morale of troops, units and formations is an important command function. It is a continuous process, which is monitored regularly by Commanders in Chain. No specific assessment of psychological conditions / morale of defence personnel has been carried out post surgical strikes. Notwithstanding this, surgical strikes by themselves were a huge morale booster for the rank and file of the Armed Forces.
