(b) whether any inquiry committee/ commission has been set up to look into the security lapses in this regard and if so, the details thereof?

(a) : Yes, Madam. As reported by Delhi Police, following explosive articles were found:

SI. No.	Explosive items recovered
1.	2" Mortar Bomb- 26
2.	White Phosphorous Grenade-22
3.	Hand Granade-05
4.	Small arms ammunition all types-44
5.	Loose Detonators-08
6.	Plastic explosive Kirkee-6.6 KG

(b): Delhi Police has reported that in this regard, a case FIR No. 17/2017 under Section 25/54/59 of The Arms Act & Section 3/4 of The Explosive Substances Act dated 06.02.2017 has been registered at Police Station Kotwali, Delhi. Army authorities have also been informed in this regard by Delhi Police. Investigation is continuing to establish the reasons for the presence of explosives.
