Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

(a) the normative and actual time taken for issuance of certificates of Skill Development Courses;

- (b) whether there has been some delay in issue of such certificates;
- (c) if so, the details thereof including the apprentices in Mumbai zone;

(d) whether the Government is considering/proposing to correct the lapses and allow the candidates to be considered for engagement for the respective establishments; and

(e) if so, the time frame proposed to resolve this issue?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (A) TO (E) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 183 TO BE ANSWERED ON 15.03.2017 ASKED BY SHRIMATI RAKSHATAI KHADSE REGARDING 'SKILL DEVELOPMENT COURSES'.

(a) to (e) The certificates are issued immediately after passing the exam and upon receipt of details of candidates from the State Directorates. There is no delay in issuance of certificates for ITI and short term courses under Modular Employable Skills (MES) as these certificates are issued On-line.

There is a delay in issuance of about 10,277 Apprentice Certificates of Mumbai Zone due to non-receipt of data from the State Directorate. To avoid delay, an Online system has been implemented for ITI students and for the trainees under Modular Employable Skills (MES) courses since more than 2 years. A similar system has already been introduced for apprentices from the current session.
