STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (c) OF THE LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 207 FOR ANSWER ON 16.03.2017 ASKED BY SHRI E.T. MOHAMMED BASHEER REGARDING BBIN MOTOR VEHICLE ACT

(a) to (c): Bangladesh, Bhutan, India and Nepal (BBIN) signed a Motor Vehicle Agreement (MVA) during the meeting of Transport Ministers of the 4 countries in June, 2015 at Thimphu, Bhutan for the regulation of passenger, personal and cargo vehicular traffic between and among Bangladesh, Bhutan, India and Nepal. The Agreement aims at facilitating seamless movement of vehicles in the sub-region. The BBIN MVA will enter into force after all the 4 countries ratify the Agreement and all the countries except Bhutan have already ratified the MVA.

Trial runs of passenger and cargo vehicles under the BBIN MVA have been conducted with the objective of incorporating experiences and learnings into the protocols for implementation of the Agreement. A trial run of cargo vehicle was conducted from Kolkata to Agartala via Dhaka (Bangladesh) in November, 2015 from India with cargo destined for Bangladesh and Northeast India. A similar trial run of cargo vehicle from Dhaka (Bangladesh) to Delhi (India) via Kolkata was also conducted during 28 August- 2 September, 2016 with the consignment destined to New Delhi. A trial run of passenger bus from Kolkata (India) to Khulna (Bangladesh) was also conducted during the same period.
