**STATEMENT REFERRED IN REPLY TO LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. \* 329 FOR ANSWER ON 24<sup>th</sup> MARCH 2017, TABLED BY SHRI SANJAY HARIBHAU JADHAV REGARDING LOANS FOR SMALL SCALE INDUSTRIES.**

(a) Loans to Small Scale Industrial units (SSIs) / Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) as defined under the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Development (MSMED) Act, 2006 are extended by individual banks on commercial basis as per their Board approved loan policy and extant instructions of Reserve Bank of India (RBI).

(b) Data relating to quantum of loan desired by SSIs is not compiled centrally. Outstanding credit to the Micro and Small Enterprises (MSE) sector by all Scheduled Commercial Banks (SCBs) during the last two years as well as current year are as under :
