NHS IN ANDHRA PRADESH

- (a) whether the National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) has targeted to construct 400 kms NHs in Andhra Pradesh during 2016-17 and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether an amount of Rs. 800 crore has been allocated for this purpose but so far the expenditure incurred is only to the extent of Rs. 150 crore; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the time by which said target is likely to be achieved?

V. SUBBA REDDY REGARDING 'NHS IN ANDHRA PRADESH'**

(a) to (c) National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) has targeted to construct 27.27 km in Andhra Pradesh during 2016-17. The actual length constructed so far during 2016-17 is 27.55 km and the expenditure incurred is Rs. 848.78 Crore.

In addition, the Ministry has also constructed 330 Km length of National Highway under NHDP Phase IV and NH(O) scheme, for which expenditure incurred is Rs. 1852.51 Crore in 2016-17.
