- (c) whether there is shortage of CAPF personnel in the country and if so, the details thereof along with the reasons therefor; and**
- (d) whether the Government proposes to increase the strength of CAPF personnel and if so, the details thereof?**

(b) to (d) : Filling up of vacancies is an ongoing and continuous process, as they arise due to reasons such as new raising, retirements, resignations etc. Vacancies are filled through various methods of recruitment such as direct recruitment, promotion or deputation as prescribed in the recruitment rules. Further, augmentation of CAPFs is a continuous process which is done as per the administrative and operational requirements of the Forces.
