- (b) whether a panel of Secretaries has also suggested the Government to make public broadcasters, Doordarshan (DD) and All India Radio (AIR), corporate entities so as to reduce their dependence on Government funds and give them elbow room to take decisions; and
- (c) if so, the reaction of the Government thereto?

(a): In the recent past, the Government had set up an Expert Committee under the Chairmanship of Shri Sam Pitroda on 28.01.2013, to review the functioning of Prasar Bharati. The Committee had submitted its Report on 24.1.2014 and recommended framing a long-term vision and strategy for Prasar Bharati that would include and be dependent upon the technology choices, assessment of human resources, review of programming, including review of existing channels and also a study of independent sources of finances for Prasar Bharati.
