SHRI DEVENDRA SINGH BHOLE:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN POVERTY ALLEVIATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has studied the recommendations of the technical group constituted to assess the shortage of houses in urban areas;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with reaction of the Government thereto; and
- (c) the steps being taken by the Government in this direction?

(a) to (c): Technical Group (TG-12) on estimation of urban housing shortage of the country for the 12th Five Year Plan (2012-17) constituted by the Ministry of Housing and Urban Poverty Alleviation estimated the total housing shortage at the beginning of 12th Plan Period i.e. in 2012, at 18.78 million.

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Government of India through its earlier schemes of Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM) and Rajiv Awas Yojana (RAY) has extended central assistance to States/UTs for providing housing to urban poor. Government has also launched 'Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Urban)' Mission on 25.06.2015 to provide central assistance to States/UTs for addressing housing requirement of all eligible urban poor. The PMAY (U) scheme guidelines require States/UTs to conduct demand assessment to arrive at the actual demand for housing among its citizens belonging to the urban poor.
