(a) & (b): Railways have decided to establish Real-time Train Information System (RTIS) for real-time tracking of all trains running on Indian Railway System.

RTIS project sanctioned at a total cost of ₹ 110 crore and its execution will start after "S-band" bandwidth is allotted by Indian Space Research Organisation.
