Will the Minister OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to construct/create bio-diversity parks in Delhi and if so, the details thereof, location and size-wise along with funds provided for the purpose;
- (b) whether all the land has been acquired by Delhi Development Authority (DDA) for the same and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) if not, the details of the land that is yet to be acquired and the time by which the land is likely to be acquired;
- (d) whether the Government has any scheme for unauthorized land under which the land owner may be provided land in place of their land; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (c): Delhi Development Authority (DDA) has informed that it has decided to develop bio-diversity parks on DDA land from the Nazul-II funds. The details are as follows:
