BANKING SERVICES IN POST OFFICES

†1147. SHRI BHANU PRATAP SINGH VERMA:

Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to start banking facilities in post offices at par with banks:
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the number of post offices operating in the country, State-wise; and
- (d) whether the Government proposes to provide ATMs to post office savings accountholders and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (IC) OF THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS & MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MANOJ SINHA)

- (a) & (b) The Department of Posts, Ministry of Communications has set up 'India Post Payments Bank' as a Public Limited Company with 100% Government of India (GoI) equity. After the grant of licence from the RBI, The India Post Payments Bank (IPPB) has launched two branches in Raipur and Ranchi on 30/01/2017 with limited banking services. A Payments Bank is a "differentiated bank" set-up under the guidelines of the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) to further financial inclusion for the underserved population by providing (i) Current and savings accounts and (ii) Payments or remittance services to migrant labour workforce, low income households, small businesses, unorganized sector entities and other users. Payments bank is similar to a universal bank, except in a few key areas, as stated below:
 - Payments Bank can accept demand deposits only i.e. savings and current accounts and will initially be restricted to holding a maximum balance of Rs. 100,000 per individual customer.
 - Payments Bank cannot accept NRI deposits
 - Payments Bank are not allowed to undertake lending activities directly and cannot grant loans
 - Payments Bank cannot set up subsidiaries to undertake non banking financial services activities.
- (c) The State/UT wise number of post offices operational in the country as on 31.03.2016 is at **Annexure –A.**
- (d) Yes Madam. As part of the IT Modernization Project the Government has decided to provide ATM facility for Post Office Savings Bank (POSB) customers. As of now 970 ATMs have been installed at major post offices across the country. The details of number of ATMs Installed is at **Annexure-B.**
