SOLAR ENERGY PROJECTS AND SOLAR LAMPS TO VILLAGES

1220. DR. BANSHILAL MAHATO:

Will the Minister of NEW & RENEWABLE ENERGY be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the solar energy projects operational in the villages along with the financial assistance provided for these projects by the Union Government, State/UT-wise;
- (b) whether the Union Government provides free of cost solar lamps to the BPL families and other beneficiaries in the villages ; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof along with the amount spent on it and the State-wise number of families provided solar lamps during the last three years and the current year, State/UT-wise including Chhattisgarh?

(a): Under Decentralized Distributed Generation (DDG) of Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Gram Jyoti Yojana (DDUGJY) implemented by Ministry of Power, a total of 852 projects (based on Solar PV) have been operational as on 31.01.2017. State-wise details are given at Annexure.
