HASSLE FREE CARGO MOVEMENT

1224. SHRI RAJAN VICHARE:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government proposes to launch any Information Technology (IT) based plan to make cargo movement across the States hassle free, seamless and smooth;

(b) if so, the details thereof including the details of the consultation made by the Government with different State Governments; and

(c) the steps taken by the Government to elicit maximum support by the State Governments in this regard?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI PON. RADHAKRISHNAN)

(a) to (c) No Madam. However to facilitate interstate goods transport, a New National Permit System for goods vehicles has been implemented in all States / Union Territories with effect from 08.05.2010. As per the new arrangement, National Permit can be granted to the goods vehicles by the home state on payment of Rs. 1000/- as home State authorization fee and Rs. 16500/- per annum per truck towards consolidated fee which authorizes the permit holder to operate throughout the country.
