1291. DR. BHAGIRATH PRASAD: SHRIMATI JAYSHREEBEN PATEL:

Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of Indian sportspersons/ athletes sent to participate in the last Olympic Games, Commonwealth Games and Asian Games along with the names of the discipline of participation;
- (b) the number of medals won in each of these events, discipline-wise;
- (c) the manner in which the Government has awarded these medal winners along with the details thereof;
- (d) the details of funds allocated and utilised on the training and other facilities provided to the sportspersons/athletes who participated in the said international events, discipline-wise; and
- (e) the number of sportspersons/ athletes failed in the anti-doping test during the said events and the quantum of punishment given to them to prevent recurrence of such incidents?

THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) FOR YOUTH AFFAIRS & SPORTS (SHRI VIJAY GOEL)

- (a) & (b) The details in respect of Rio Olympic-2016, Glasgow Commonwealth Games-2014 and Incheon Asian Games-2014 are given in the Annexure I.
- (c) Incentives in the form of cash awards are given to medal winners and their coaches in international events as per the provisions of the scheme of

'Special Awards to Medal Winners in Sports Events and their Coaches', which are given below:

Further, the Government honours the Sportspersons and Coaches by conferring various awards such as Padma Awards, Arjuna Award; Dronacharya Award, Rajiv Gandhi Khel Ratna Award, Dhyan Chand Award, etc.

- (d) Under the Scheme of Assistance to NSFs, financial assistance to the identified sportspersons/teams is given for national coaching camps, Foreign Exposures / Competitions, State-of-the-art equipment, etc. Details of funds allocated under this scheme during the last 3 years and the current financial year, discipline-wise, are given at Annexure II. Government also provides financial assistance to elite sportspersons under the National Sports Development Fund for personalized training/coaching, participation in international tournaments, purchase of sports equipment etc. Details of fund released from NSDF are given at Annexure III.
- (e) National Anti Doping Agency (NADA), which is responsible enforcing the anti-doping code in the country, is not the Result Management Authority (RMA) in the Olympics, Commonwealth Games and Asian Games. Hence no information pertaining to athletes failed in the anti-doping test in these events is available.
