#### SHYAMA PRASAD MUKHERJI RURBAN MISSION

#### 1292. SHRI KONDA VISHWESHWAR REDDY:

Will the Minister of **RURAL DEVELOPMENT** be pleased to state:

- (a) the salient features of the Shyama Prasad Mukherji Rurban Mission (SPMRM) along with the targets set under the said scheme for 2016-17;
- (b) whether various State Governments including Telangana have submitted proposals to be considered under this scheme;
- (c) if so, the details thereof along with the status of each of those proposals;
- (d) the funds allocated, sanctioned and utilised for implementation of the said scheme for the current financial year along with the funds sharing pattern between the Union Government and the State/UT Governments including Telangana; and
- (e) the timeline set for the full implementation of various phases under this scheme?

# ANSWER MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI RAM KRIPAL YADAV)

(a): The Shyama Prasad Mukherji Rurban Mission, approved by the Union Cabinet on September 16<sup>th</sup>, 2015 and launched by the Prime Minister on February 21<sup>st</sup>, 2016, is a flagship programme of this Government. It is a unique programme, with scientifically laid out principles of policy and programme implementation, designed to deliver catalytic interventions to rural areas, on the threshold of growth. Under this Mission, 300 clusters in rural areas, across all States and UTs, with latent potential for growth, are identified across the country following clearly enunciated methodologies articulated in the framework of implementation. The Mission through financial and technical support, aims at plugging the critical gaps in basic, social, economic and digital amenities in these clusters.

### **Achievements and Targets for 2016-17**

- The programme has gained great momentum since the launch of the Mission in February, 2016.
- 98 clusters under Phase 1, have been identified and approved in 28 States. Integrated Cluster Action Plans (ICAPs), which are the blue prints of development of these clusters, have been prepared and submitted by 25 States for 82 clusters and approved by the Ministry.
- Rs. 288.23 crores of the allocated Rs 300 crores in FY 2016-17, has been released and work in these clusters have already commenced on the ground.
- In addition Rs 118.90 crores has been further released from the supplementary grant of Rs 300 crores allocated for the Mission.
- The remaining 6 States are preparing their plans and by February, 2016 all 98 clusters under Phase 1 of this Mission, would have approved plans and would be ready for implementation.

- States and UTs are also now identifying clusters under Phase 2 of the Mission and the Ministry aims to approve the list of 100 more clusters, by end of February, 2016.
- (b): 98 clusters under Phase 1, have been identified and approved in 28 States. Integrated Cluster Action Plans (ICAPs), which are the blue prints of development of these clusters, have been prepared and submitted by 25 States for 82 clusters and approved by the Ministry. The remaining 6 States are preparing their plans and by February, 2016 all 98 clusters under Phase 1 of this Mission, would have approved plans and would be ready for implementation. The State Government of Telangana has also submitted their plans in the ICAPs submitted for 2016-17.

- (d): The total fund allocated during 2016-17 at BE stage was Rs.300 crores and the Mission was approved as a Central Sector Scheme with 100% funding by GoI. Rs. 300 crores was released to the states and the supplementary grant of Rs.300 crores was further approved in RE stage for the Mission. Of this, Rs. 118.90 crores has been released to the States. These releases are made upon submission of proposals by States in the ICAPs which are then approved by the Ministry. During the RE stage an OM from NITI Aayog No.66(01)PF-II/20 re-categorized the scheme as a centrally sponsored scheme and the funds sharing ratio was redesigned with 60% to come from GoI and 40% from States.
- (e): The timelines for implementation of the Mission for each cluster commences in 2016-17 and is spread over 3 years. The clusters approved in 2016-17 will complete in 2018-19, those approved in 2017-18 will complete in 2019-20 and those approved in 2018-19 will complete in 2020-2021.

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
