#### **RENEWABLE STATUS TO HYDRO POWER PROJECTS**

#### 1298. SHRI B. VINOD KUMAR:

Will the Minister of POWER be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is any proposal to accord renewable energy status to large hydro power projects so as to keep power tariffs low;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

#### ANSWER

#### (SHRI PIYUSH GOYAL)

- (a) to (c): The Government is seized of the issue of promoting hydro power and improving its saleability by bringing down hydro tariff through suitable interventions. An Expert Committee was formed under the Chairpersonship of Ex. Chairman, Central Water Commission (CWC), which held consultations with stakeholders and studied global practices in hydro power across the World. The recommendations of the Committee were presented during the Power Ministers Conference held at Vadodara from 7<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> Oct. 2016 and the resolutions agreed upon by the participating States are as under:-
  - Declaring all hydropower (irrespective of size) as renewable energy which would ensure:
    - (i) All hydropower would be covered under Renewable Purchase Obligation
    - (ii) All hydropower would get qualified for dispatch priority
  - Extending renewable energy benefits upto 100 MW projects (by increasing the earlier upper limit of 25 MW)
  - Extending low cost credit to hydropower projects >100 MW from Coal Cess.

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
