Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether most of the important National Highways stretches are in dilapidated conditions resulting in accidents;
- (b) if so, whether the Government has allocated funds for maintenance and repair of the existing National Highways stretches;
- (c) if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether the Government proposes to take any steps to ensure proper monitoring and maintenance of National Highways stretches; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

**ANSWER**

- (a) Development and Maintenance of National Highways (NHs) is a continuous process and they are kept in traffic worthy condition depending upon the availability of funds and inter se priority.
- (b) to (c) Funds allocated for maintenance and repair of the existing National Highways stretches are at Annexure-I.
- (d) to (e) Regular meetings are held with project developers, State Governments and contractors. Regular review meetings are held in Head Quarter by Ministry with Regional Officers, concessionaires /contractors to make the construction of projects hassle free and to keep the road in traffic worthy condition within available resources.
