**PROMOTION OF USE OF SOLAR PUMPS**

Will the Minister of NEW & RENEWABLE ENERGY be pleased to state:

- (a) whether as per survey there are two crore and ten lakh irrigation pumps in the country out of which 90 lakh pumps are run on diesel and the remaining pumps are operated on electricity from the grid which is 10 to 15 per cent of total power consumption in the country; and
- (b) if so, the steps taken/being taken by the Government to promote use of solar pumps in place of diesel and electric pumps for pisciculture, horticulture, drinking water supply and salt production in addition to irrigation for agriculture in the villages?
