- (a) the present number of units of Handloom, Powerloom, Synthetic yarn, readymade clothes and those producing hosiery as on date, State and location-wise;
- (b) the amount spent for the development of textile industry by the Government under various schemes during each of the last three years and the current year; and
- (c) the steps taken/proposed to be taken by the Government to boost the export of clothes produced by such units?

- (a) The number of units in the textiles Sector are at Annexures A, B and C.
- (b) The details of the amount spent for development of textile industry through various sectoral scheme during the last three years and current year is at Annexure D.
- (c) With a view to boost the Export of Clothes produced by Textile Units Government is implementing various Schemes such as Technology Upgradation Fund Scheme (TUFS), Scheme for Development of Technical Textiles, Schemes for the Development of the Powerloom Sector, Scheme for Integrated Textile Parks (SITP), Integrated Skill Development Scheme (ISDS), Schemes for Development of Silk and Sericulture sectors, National Handloom Development Programme (NHDP), Comprehensive Handloom Cluster Development Scheme(CHCDS), Yarn supply Scheme, In situ Upgradation of Plain Powerloom Scheme for upgrading the obsolete Powerlooms to semi-automatic and automatic looms, North East Region Textiles Promotion Scheme (NERTPS), etc.

Besides the above schemes, the Government has recently approved a special package to boost production, employment generation and export in the Apparel and made ups Sector which includes enhanced subsidy of 25% to garmenting units, under Amended-TUFS based on their production and employment output; Enhanced Duty Draw Back; Amendment in Section 80JJAA of Income Tax Act and modification of Labour Laws to support the garmenting sector. These Schemes are aimed at setting up of new units as well as expansion of the existing units.
