CONSTRUCTION OF HIGHWAYS IN TELANGANA

1441. SHRI PRABHAKAR REDDY KOTHA:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has decided to construct Highways in the State of Telangana, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the details of the highway projects being taken up particularly in the Medak district; and
- (c) the quantum of funds allocated for this purpose?

ANSWER

(a) Yes, Madam. 10 nos. of works amounting to Rs. 2023 crore under NH (O) and one work amounting to Rs. 605 crore under NHDP Phase-IV have been sanctioned during 2016-17 for development of National Highways in Telangana.

(b) Ministry has sanctioned Improvement work from Km 493/0 to 524/0 of Pune-Hyderabad section of NH-65 (Old NH-9) passing through Medak District in the State of Telangana for Rs. 48.22 crore during 2016-17 and the work is under progress. The Sangareddy-Nanded-Akola section of NH-161 also passes through Medak District. This stretch has been assigned to National Highway Authority of India (NHAI) for development to 4 lane standards.

(c) The details of allocation and expenditure during 2016-17 for National Highways in Telangana are as under:-

In addition, one work of 99 km length with total capital cost of Rs. 1905 crore has been awarded by NHAI in Telangana.
