(a) & (b) Yes Madam, funds are allocated for the State of Assam under National Highway (Original) [NH(O)], Special Accelerated Road Development Programme for North East (SARDP-NE) for development National Highways and Central Road Fund (CRF) for development of State Highways/Roads. These allocations are made State wise for NH (O) and CRF and for the entire North Eastern Region for SARDP-NE. The details of funds allocated and release during the last three years and current year is as given below:
