1468. SHRI RABINDRA KUMAR JENA:

Will the Minister of TEXTILES वस्त्र मंत्री be pleased to state :

- (a) the share of the textile sector in the Gross Domestic Product (GDP) of the country during each of the last two years;
- (b) the percentage of workforce in the country which is employed in the textile sector and the details of jobs generated in the textile sector during the said period;
- (c) the production output and the growth rate of exports of the textile sector during the said period; and
- (d) the various initiatives taken by the Government to increase the textile sector's contribution to the country's economy?

- (a): As per the National Accounts Statistics (NAS), the share of the textiles manufacturing to Gross Domestic Products is 1.89% (2012-13) and 1.87% in 2013-14.
- **(b):** As per the Annual Survey of Industry (ASI), the percentage of workforce employed in Textiles and Wearing Apparel of formal sector among major industries is 18.73% in 2012-13 and 18.28% in 2013-14.

(c): Production and growth rate of export of the textile sector during 2014-15 and 2015-16 are given in a table below:-
