- (a) the present status of Bina river irrigation project in Madhya Pradesh along with the total number of phases of its completion including the total number of phases completed till date;
- (b) whether there is any inordinate delay in its completion, if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the steps taken/to be taken by the Government for its completion within stipulated time?

(a) to (c) Water resources projects are planned, funded, executed and maintained by the State Governments themselves as per their own resources and priority. In order to supplement their efforts, Ministry of Water Resources, River Development and Ganga Rejuvenation (MoWR, RD & GR) provides financial assistance to State Governments to encourage sustainable development and efficient management of water resources through various schemes such as Accelerated Irrigation Benefits Programme (AIBP) etc. under Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY).

Detailed Project Report (DPR) of Bina river irrigation project of Madhya Pradesh was received in Central Water Commission (CWC) during 2010 for appraisal. The comments/observations of CWC were communicated to the project authorities. The revised DPR incorporating the compliance on the same was not submitted by the State Government and the DPR of the project is now treated as deemed returned.
