(a) to (d) A Committee was constituted by the Ministry of Water Resources, River Development and Ganga Rejuvenation, in September 2015, under the Chairmanship of Dr. Mihir Shah, Former Member, erstwhile Planning Commission, for restructuring of Central Water Commission (CWC) and Central Ground Water Board (CGWB) for optimal development of water resources in the country in the backdrop of integrated water resources management. The Committee has submitted its report in July 2016 to the Ministry and has recommended merging of the CWC and the CGWB to make a National Water Commission (NWC). The Committee has further recommended the staffing pattern of the NWC. The report submitted by the Committee is under consideration in the Ministry.
