FUNDS ALLOCATION UNDER PMGSY IN KERALA

1601. SHRIMATI P.K. SREEMATHI TEACHER:

Will the Minister of **RURAL DEVELOPMENT** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of funds allocated, released and spent under the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) during the last three years and the current year in the State of Kerala;
- (b) the details of road projects completed during the said period in the State, Projectwise; and
- (c) the details of ongoing work/ pending work under PMGSY in the State?

ANSWER MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI RAM KRIPAL YADAV)

(a) to (c): 'Rural Roads' is a State subject and Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) is a one-time special intervention of the Central Government to provide rural connectivity, by way of a single all-weather road, to the eligible unconnected habitations in the Core Network. Since inception of PMGSY, 1,436 Roads/Bridges have been sanctioned to the State of Kerala for constructing/upgrading 3,534.891 km road length (both PMGSY and PMGSY-II) (upto 31.1.2017). The State has reported that out of these projects 1,192 Roads/Bridges have been completed by constructing 2,774.633 km road length (upto 31.1.2017). The details of fund allocated, released and spent under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana(PMGSY) in the last three years and the current year to Kerala are given below:-
