Will the Minister of DEFENCE j{kk ea=h be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Indian Navy has any proposal to commission warships and catamarans into its fleet;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether there is huge delay in supplying vessels to the Navy by the contractors;

(d) if so, the reasons for delay and the action taken by the Indian Navy against the errant suppliers; and

(e) the time by which the new fleets of vessels are likely to be commissioned and put into operation?

(a) to (e): The induction of various classes of vessels into Indian Navy is an ongoing process, as part of the capacity building and modernization of the Navy. At present a number of vessels, including state of the art indigenous warships, are on order with Indian Shipyards and are expected to be commissioned during the period 2017-2025. Delays in shipbuilding projects are dealt with in accordance with provisions in Contracts.
