- (a) the details of the newly approved State Highways and National Highways(NHs) passing through Marathwada region particularly Solapur, Usmanabad and Latur region;

(a) to (c) This ministry is responsible for the development of National Highways(NHs). Eleven new National Highways have been declared in the Marathwada region of Maharashtra. Funds are allocated State wise and not NH wise. Funds for development of NHs for the State of Maharashtra is Rs. 2000 crore. The up-gradation work for these NHs are put up on tender for their commencement.
