HEALTH DISORDERS IN CHILDREN

1830. SHRI P.R. SUNDARAM:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government or WHO have conducted survey of the current status and data of children with severe health disorders in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the various steps taken by the Government in this regard;
- (c) whether the Government has any plans to initiate and promote awareness programme on infant mortality, malnutrition, hygiene, dental and eye care; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the list of awareness projects implemented in the country and the details of the funds provided for these awareness projects in the last three years, State-wise, year-wise?

(a) & (b): Under National Health Mission, the Government of India is implementing Rashtriya Bal Swasthya Karyakram (RBSK), for screening of children from 0-18 years of age including children in Government schools for 30 selected health conditions. The aim of the programme is early detection and management of the 4Ds - i.e. Defects at birth, Diseases, Deficiencies and Development delays.

During FY 2015-16, a total of 18.7 crore children were screened and 87.8 lakh children were identified and referred for their management.

(c) & (d): The Government of India is implementing various health and awareness promotion activities including child health, nutrition, hygiene, dental and eye care.
