- (a) the number of industries functioning /operational in the state of Madhya Pradesh, location-wise;
- (b) whether any criteria has been fixed by the Government and the State Government of Madhya Pradesh regarding the said operational industries;
- (c) if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether the Government and the State Government of Madhya Pradesh have provided any special facilities to the said operational industries;
- (e) if so, the details thereof ;
- (f) whether the local persons have been given jobs among the officers/employees working in the said operational industries; and
- (g) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a): As per information available, 4 Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs) were in operation as on 31.03.2016 in the State of Madhya Pradesh. Location –wise details are given below.
