(a) to (c): There is no separate proposal to diversify cereal based cropping system in the country. However, in order to encourage diversified production of various crops, Government of India is already implementing crop development programme of National Food Security Mission (NFSM), which comprised of 5 components i.e. NFSM-Rice, Wheat, Pulses, Coarse Cereals and Commercial Crops, by adopting regionally differentiated cropping system approach. NFSM provides support for promotion of new varieties of these crops including nutritionally rich varieties of cereals.
