DECREASE IN LIVESTOCK POPULATION

Will the minister of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्री
be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that a large number of livestock are badly affected due to various livestock's diseases;
- (b) if so, whether the number of suicides by farmers is increasing due to poverty caused by the shortage of livestock;
- (c) the steps taken/being taken by the Government for providing animal fodder to farmers;
and
- (d) the details of the total amount of funds allocated by the Government to various States for promotion of livestock population in the country during the last three years, State-wise?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE

(a) & (b) As per the animal disease reports available with the Department of Animal Husbandry, Dairying & Fisheries, there have been gradual reduction in numbers of animals affected by livestock diseases. With the implementation of National Animal Disease Control programmes, the outbreaks of major economically important diseases of livestock have been drastically reduced since 2005. Foot & Mouth Disease (FMD) outbreak which were 2270 in 2005 have been reduced to 109 in 2015. Similarly, the outbreak of Haemorrhagic Septicemia (HS), Anthrax and Peste des Petits Ruminants (PPR) which were 775, 72 and 1071 respectively during 2005 have also been considerably reduced to 89, 28 and 116 outbreaks respectively during 2015. Similarly, during 2013, a total of 115597 no. of animal were affected due to major livestock diseases such as FMD, HS, BQ, Anthrax, PPR and Swine Fever where as in the year 2016 (January to October) the total number of livestock affected due to same disease have been reduced.

(c) To ensure availability of Feed & Fodder Department of Animal Husbandry, Dairying and Fisheries (DADF), Government of India is providing financial assistance to the farmers/ Co-operatives through the States/UTs under Centrally Sponsored Scheme National Livestock Mission with a Sub Mission on Feed and Fodder Development with the following components:-

1. Fodder Production from Non-forest wasteland/rangeland/grassland/non-arable land.
2. Fodder production from Forest land.
3. Fodder Seed Procurement/Production & Distribution.
4. Introduction of Hand Driven Chaff-Cutter
5. Introduction of Power Driven Chaff-Cutter
6. Distribution of low capacity, tractor mountable fodder block making units, hay baling machines/reapers/forage harvesters
7. Establishment of silage making units
8. Establishment of by-pass protein production units
9. Establishment of Area Specific Mineral mixture /Feed Pelleting/Feed Manufacturing Unit.
10. Establishment/modernization of Feed Testing Laboratories.

(d) The details of funds released to the States/UTs under various schemes related to development of livestock i.e. National Programme for Bovine Breeding, National Kamdhenu Breeding Centre, Livestock Health and Disease Control, National Livestock Mission (NLM) during last three years are annexed at **Annexure A to D**.
