(a) to (c): The Central Government organises a Conference of Director Generals of Police (DGsP)/Inspector Generals of Police (IGsP) every year wherein issues such as challenges to internal security, policing, disaster management etc. are discussed. During the last three years, the conference was held at Guwahati from 29<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> November, 2014, at Rann of Kachchh from 18<sup>th</sup> to 20 December, 2015 and at Hyderabad from 25<sup>th</sup> December to 27<sup>th</sup> December, 2016.

The recommendations of the conference are sent to all the stakeholders concerned for implementation. The status of implementation of recommendations is reviewed periodically and the implementation report is also presented in the next year's DGsP/IGsP Conference.
